PART 1

CURFEW

§5-101. Hours Affecting Minors

It shall be unlawful for minors under 18 years of age to be or remain in or upon any of the streets, alleys, parks or public places in the Borough, except as hereinafter provided, between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., prevailing time, unless such minor is accompanied by his or her parent, guardian or other person having custody of such minor.

§5-102. Permitting Violations

It shall be unlawful for any parent, guardian or other person having the care or custody of any minor under the age of 18 to allow or permit such child, while in such custody to go or be in or upon any of the streets, alleys, parks or public places in the Borough after the time prohibited in §5-101 of this Part, except as provided herein.

§5-103. Violations and Penalties

Any minor as above designated found upon the Borough streets, alleys, parks or public places within the Borough, in violation of §5-101 of this Part shall be taken into custody by the Borough Police and delivered to his or her parents, guardian or person having custody of said minor.

§5-104. Repeat Offenders

Any minor violating the provisions of this Part more than three times shall be reported to the Juvenile Court of Cambria County as an incorrigible or delinquent person.

§5-105. Determining Age

Police officers shall use their discretion in determining age and in doubtful cases may require positive proof, and until such time as proof is furnished, the officer's judgment shall prevail.

§5-106. Minors Attending Functions

Minors attending school, church or other sponsored functions shall not be required to comply with the provisions of this Part until 15 minutes after such functions have been concluded.
