Mylo Park Welcome to Ebensburg Sign

The Borough has received very positive comments about the new Welcome to Ebensburg sign installed last year near Lake Rowena. The first of five planned entrance signs was underwritten by the Ebensburg Rotary Club. The Rotary Club is so pleased with the results of this first sign that they have agreed to pay for a second sign to be erected on the west side of town near Holy Name Cemetery.

If any other organization or business wishes to contribute toward the cost of additional entrance signs, contact Dan at the borough office. Other signs are planned on Route 422 near Bishop Carroll, Center Street near the former middle school, and Center Street near Agway.

DOWNTOWN FLOWERS

Residents will soon see large flower pots added throughout the downtown area. The flower pots will be placed within the bricked section of the sidewalks found along Center Street & High Street. Each one will be positioned in front of a business that has agreed to maintain the flowers. The Borough, along with the Ebensburg Main Street Partnership, has purchased and will place the flower pots and fill them with soil. The caretakers are then required to acquire and plant flowers each spring and care for them, including regular watering.

Upcoming Sewer System Project

Yet another very expensive project is on the horizon at the sewage treatment plant.

The PA Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is requiring all municipalities to reduce the amount of stormwater entering the sewage treatment system. Ebensburg has been taking measures to comply with that order for several years. That is the purpose of the smoke testing that we have been performing, and the follow-up enforcement actions requiring downspouts to be disconnected. It is important for us to eliminate illegal connections and reduce the amount of stormwater in the sewage system, because DEP



will require us to eliminate the combined sewer overflows (CSOs) by September 2017. The CSOs currently handle any overflows to the sewage treatment plant by discharging excess flows to the stream. Once the CSOs are eliminated, the treatment plant will flood unless an alternative is constructed.



Ebensburg's \$5.1 million water system improvement project is wrapping up. New distribution mains have been installed near Mylo Park, in Crestwood Estates and throughout the southeast corner of Ebensburg. A new backwash tank has been constructed at the water treatment plant, and the plant itself received a major upgrade including a much improved filtering system. New control valves were installed throughout the system.

New Water Meters

The installation of new water meters and/ or radio-read sensors for all water customers will be completed by the end of summer. The new meters are required in order to be compatible with our new radio-read metering system. Once the meters are all installed, it will no longer be necessary for borough workers to visit each customer to read water meters. The new meter will transmit a radio signal to the borough office allowing us to read each water meter at any time. The new system will also be capable of recognizing when a customer's flow has increased more than normal, indicating a possible water leak.

2013 SIDEWALK PROJECTS

The 2013 residential sidewalk project was relatively small and included only East Ogle Street next to the courthouse. In a joint project with Cambria County, a new sidewalk was installed. East Ogle Street will then be resurfaced in July.

There is one other sidewalk project being planned, and that is High Street. Because it is a State road, it is handled differently than our other residential sidewalk projects. High Street

will not be completed until 2014 or 2015, but Keller Engineers was engaged this year to complete the design for the project. This project includes completion of new sidewalks on East High Street to the Lake Rowena bridge, new sidewalks on West High Street from Beech Street to Sheetz, and new sidewalks on South Center Street from Ogle Street to Prave Street.

The ongoing sidewalk replacement project has contributed greatly to the rejuvenation of Ebensburg. It is the first thing noticed by those traveling through Ebensburg. It is important that we complete all of High Street as soon as possible.

Ebensburg's Borough Pool Making a Splash

After an exciting opening season in 2012, the newly renovated Ebensburg Borough Swimming Pool's second season is in fullswing! Ebensburg's pool project has given families, friends and neighbors outstanding recreational benefits and fun beyond compare: heated pool with state-of-the-art filtration system, convenient zero-depth beach access entry and toddler and intermediate areas with their own water features.

The Ebensburg swimming pool provides positive, affordable and accessible activities for the entire community. The pool opens every day at noon and remains open during the week days (Monday through Friday) until 8pm and on the weekends we will remain open until 6pm. Fees for the pool are \$6 for adults and \$4 for children for a day pass. Season passes are now available for families of any size; they can be purchased at the pool during normal business hours.

The pool is also available for private rentals as well after the hours of operation. The pool can be rented any day during the week starting at 8pm and on the weekends starting at 6pm.

Playground Upgrades

Borough Council has awarded contracts for over \$13,000 to replace old playground equipment at four different sites. Outside of the right field fence at Lake



Field a new swing set will be installed, and the existing wood bleachers will be replaced. A new swing set will also be installed near the pavilion at Lake Rowena. A third new swing set will be installed on the east side of Lake Rowena near the flag pole. And finally, a new swing set will be installed near the borough swimming pool. New swinging benches will be installed along the shore of Jenck's Dam and near the basketball courts.



DOWNTOWN SIGNAGE PROJECT

The Ebensburg Borough is in the process of developing a set of guidelines for new and existing businesses who are looking to create or improve their storefront signage. The goals of the signage guidelines will be to encourage businesses to improve the historic appearance of our downtown area, and make themselves more visible to both pedestrians and motorists. Businesses will be encouraged to incorporate an artistic quality that reflects the character and history of their business and the downtown Ebensburg area. Downtown Ebensburg is the symbolic center of our community with an active flow and attractive pedestrian environment. It is our hope that pedestrian-friendly signage will promote more walk-in trade and make downtown Ebensburg a more active area for the community to enjoy.
