



# Examples for Menu Items

## Drinks

| Ale            | A malt beverage, darker, heavier, and more bitter than beer                       |
| Smoking Bishop | Christmas punch made from heated red wine flavored with oranges, sugar and spices |
| Bumper         | Generous glass of an alcoholic beverage   |
| Flip           | Mixture of beer and spirits, sweetened with sugar and heated with a hot iron      |
| Ginger Beer    | Non-alcoholic beverage flavored with ginger                                       |
| Grog           | Mixture of rum and water used by captains to dilute sailors' drinks               |
| Mead           | A fermented beverage made of water and honey, malt and yeast                      |
| Negus          | Liquor made from wine, water, sugar, nutmeg, and lemon juice                      |
| Port           | Sweet red wine from Portugal  |
| Purl           | Hot beer mixed in gin   |
| Srub (Shrub)   | A drink made from orange or lemon juice, sugar or rum and brandy                  |
| Wassail        | Spiced Ale served at Christmas  |

Victorian (Tea) Sandwich      Small square of crust less bread with odd toppings (Ham & Cheese, Turkey & Cheese, Pimento Cheese Spread, Sun Dried tomato Cheese Spread)

Dicken's Duo      Half sandwich and a cup of soup

# Desserts

Scone      Flat muffin, filled with raisins, or fruit topping

Cobbler      Pie made with fresh fruit

Gems      Yellow cake, raspberry jam, icing sugar

Cratchit's Cinnamon Crunch Almonds      Baked Almonds tossed in a cinnamon and sugar mixture

Biffins      Baked apples flattened into pancakes

Crumpet      A light muffin usually served with tea
