Old Business:

Pool

- -The pool project was about 75% completed. Mike Avalotis and his team decided not to pursue the painting of the pool as they needed 5-7 days of 70 degrees and no rain in order for the paint to set. This was also discussed with the Borough Manager and all were in agreement for them to resume in May.
- -All sprinklers were painted and refreshed in the shallow end.
- -Avalotis will leave proper paint to touch up areas of the shallow end that are discolored and stained after last season. A new coat of paint will be added to the stained parts of the shallow area with a non-skid material to prevent slips.
- -9 new lawn chairs were delivered and stored in the shed.
- -Mike and his team from Kircon-Breco winterized the pool on 11/4/24.
- -RD filled the pool on 11/3/24 for the winter.
- -The stairs and rails are being replaced on the large red slide due to being rusted. Mark Ford will be in touch for installation.

Memorial Fields

- -Awaiting on grant notification
- -Received an email from the Ebensburg Softball League. She voiced concerns over the condition of the fields last year, the condition of the bathrooms and the concession stand. I did update her on the grant for fixing the fields. I assured her the bathrooms and concession stand would be properly taken care of.

YPCC
