3. KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

- Completed a Historic Downtown Mural Project in partnership with CCHS art students and teacher, Mr. Brian Dumm
- Invited CCHS Band to perform at Memorial Day Ceremony in Veteran's Park and Boy Scout to do the honors of raising the service flags.
- o Requested the Boy Scout Troop help with set-up and tear-down of Art in Bloom.
- Invited all area youth groups to march in Memorial Day and Christmas Parades.
- Host the students of Saint Francis University to help with all aspects of PotatoFest.

- o Facilitated volunteer park clean-up days and fall decorating day.
- Hosted Volunteer Appreciation Night to thank volunteers with dinner, dessert, drinks and a prize raffle.

- Funded the Historic Downtown Ebensburg Mural High & Cherry Streets
- Sponsored a new Funbrella at the Ebensburg Borough Swimming Pool
- Funded the Justin Yahner Memorial Scoreboard Project at Lake Rowena Ballfield
- Purchased new patriotic lamppost banners for the downtown
- Funded downtown hanging flower basket and planters project.
- Partnered with Girl Scouts to place and promote their Silver Award Labyrinth Trail
 Project near the Ebensburg Upper Reservoir

- Hosted Lt. Governor Austin Davis for a Main Streets press event and downtown walking tour.
- Awarded a grant of \$50k to fund façade improvement projects.
- Hosted Small Business Saturday retail contest.

- Hosted and promoted annual schedule of events to include Art in Bloom, Wheels & Wings, Movies in the Park, Concerts in the Park, Homecoming Weekend, PotatoFest, Dickens of a Christmas and more.
- Maintained partnership with Visit Johnstown, Cambria County and Cambria Regional Chamber to further promote Ebensburg and our events.
- Awarded National Main Street Center accreditation for the 10th year in a row.

- Promote and celebrate the 200th Anniversary of the Incorporation of Ebensburg Borough.

- Apply for Small Town Challenge Endowment Fund through Community Foundation of the Alleghenies.
- Set-up an online store of Ebensburg merchandise.
- Host a successful schedule of community events.
- Distribute facade improvement project grand funds.
