INVITATION TO BID

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Crosswalk with Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB)

The borough of Ebensburg is seeking bids from qualified Bidders to install a marked crosswalk, pedestrian warning signs and pedestrian actuated Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB) at the intersection of West High Street (SR 1036) and Julian Street, Ebensburg, PA 15931. Quantities shown here are for illustrating the scope of the project only. It is the contractor's responsibility to determine construction quantities.

A (non-mandatory) pre-bid conference, including a site visit of the project area, will be conducted on Monday, April 21st, 2025, at 10:00 A.M. Prospective bidders are encouraged to meet at the intersection of West High Street (SR 1036) and Julian Street, Ebensburg, PA 15931.

The Borough of Ebensburg will receive sealed Bids until 12:00 noon local prevailing time Thursday, April 24th, 2025, at 300 West High Street, Ebensburg, PA 15931. Bidding Documents may be examined or obtained during normal office hours at the borough office, 300 West High Street, Ebensburg, PA 15931 (814) 472-8780 or obtained on-line at www.ebensburgpa.com.. Proposals must be on forms provided by the Borough. Bids will be opened at 12:00 Noon on April 24th, 2025 and considered for approval at the Council meeting on Monday, April 28th, 2025, at 6:30PM.

The project is a prevailing wage project, subject to the Pa. Prevailing Wage Act, and as such the wage rate determination is attached. The contract provisions, including prevailing wage requirements, apply to work performed on the contract by the contractor and sub-contractors.

Bid Security in the amount of 10% of the Bid must accompany the Bid. A performance bond in the amount of 100% of the contract will be required of the successful bidder. The Borough of Ebensburg reserves the right to waive irregularities and reject any and all Bids.
