OLD BUSINESS:

YPCC:

-A request for bid was drawn up for the interior roof repair. This will be presented to the council on 6/23/25.

POOL:

-The Rec Board was updated on the repair of the water/filtration pump, the purchase of a CAT 5000 sensors, the purchase of a chlorine pump, the installation of new tubing for the chlorine system, and the installation of the kiddie slide.

-The Rec Board was updated on the renovations completed, which include repair of the women's bathroom ceiling, mold removal, and painting. All picnic tables in the pavilions were painted, the grounds were mulched, and flowers were planted, and the exterior bathroom walls were cleaned and painted.

New Business:

YPCC:

-The summer workers have been tending to the public bathrooms as well as mowing of the dog park.

-16 new basketballs were purchased for open gym time. This was funded by the 501 3 C account.

-A youth K-2 basketball clinic is scheduled for August 4, 2025 from 5-7 at the YPCC. This is an instructional camp for those children interested in playing basketball in the winter.

-A community survey will be conducted to assess the transformation of the existing hockey rink into permanent pickleball courts. Members were asked to provide some questions they would like to see on the survey.

-The Holy Name Playground basketball court has been painted with lines for play. We continue to work on the other playgrounds throughout town.

TENNIS CENTER:

-Council agreed to the bid provided by Gittings to install a new fire alarm system. Contact was made with Mark from Gittings, and he plans to evaluate the project within the next two weeks.
