OLD BUSINESS:

YPCC:

- The proposal to bid was published in the Tribune Democrat on August 9th and 13th for the YPCC roof repair. Site visit is scheduled for August 14th. All bids to be submitted by August 25th.
- The online survey regarding transitioning the existing hockey rink to permanent pickleball courts closed on July 28th. The results were: Yes to change the rink: 53, NO to leave the rink as it is: 76. Responses were taken from Ebensburg Borough residents only.

POOL:

- The RD as well as the borough manager, and the engineer met and discussed the cleanup of the debris in the creek behind the pool. Maintenance was involved and is scheduling the cleanup.

TENNIS CENTER:

- Gittings fully installed the fire alarm system. No problems reported at this time.

MEMORIAL BALLFIELDS:

-A lock and alarm system was partially installed on the bathrooms, storage shed, and concession stand by Gittings. They are waiting for the locks to come in and to be placed on the doors. The men's room door needs to be fixed/replaced as it does not close on its own. Maintenance was notified. This is ongoing.

YPCC:

-The Halloween party is scheduled for October 26th from 3-5. Ashley Bobby and Melanie Keller have volunteered to assist in the planning. The party will feature a vendor show, a bounce house, games, face painting, and indoor trick-or-treating for the community.

-The gymnasium will need to be closed for 5-7 days for the roof repair. Dates depend on bids/scheduling. The community will be notified via Facebook and signage at the YPCC.
