***OLD BUSINESS:***

**YPCC:**

- A new rower (Contour 2) and spin bike (Lifefitness) were purchased and delivered. Members like the new equipment.
- The winter basketball league is finishing up. No issues currently.
- Security checks will continue to be conducted at the YPCC from 9PM to 12 AM on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays.

**LAKE ROWENA GRANT:**

- Outdoor lighting and security quotes were discussed with the borough manager and Comcast. Bids to be sent out after the dredging bid is determined.
- The concession stand and restroom changes were made and are awaiting new plans from the engineer.

**POOL:**

- Amler Grant due October 2026. RD to follow up with the Borough Manager.
- Non-slip mats were discussed for the shallow end. The group decided a self-adhesive/flat non-slip strip would be best to avoid any tripping hazards. Samantha Kemock motioned, Amber Mesoras seconded.
- Pool staff will be determined after March 15<sup>th</sup>. Necessary hiring will be done if needed.

*New Business:*

**MEMORIAL BALLFIELDS:**

-Ebensburg Borough received the LSG in the amount of \$42,000 to have McDonald's Field and First Energy Field reconstructed. One competitive bid was received in the amount of \$108,300, which was rejected by council. The RFB was reposted with a deadline of March 17<sup>th</sup>. RD hopes the project will be completed by April 30<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting.

-A lease was developed for Ebensburg Youth League for McDonald's Field in the duration of six years with a rental payment of \$750. A lease was developed for Bishop Carroll Softball for a duration of one year and a rental fee of \$750. The rental payment was discussed with the group and it was agreed it would help with the maintenance of the fields in the future. Approval of the leases and rental payments motioned by Amber Mesoras and seconded by Ashley Bobby.

**YPCC:**

-Brighten the Burg project will be held on April 29<sup>th</sup> by CCHS Juniors and Seniors. Various locations within the borough will be weeded, mulched, cleaned, and painted. The borough staff will be on site to assist.

**LAKE FIELD:**

-Opening day for Ebensburg Youth League Baseball will be May 1<sup>st</sup> at the Lake Field.

Ashley Bobby was voted in for a three-year term. Motioned by Samantha Kemcock, Seconded by Amber Mesoras.
